Averklub Collective. Manuș heißt Mensch



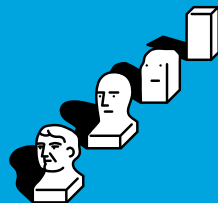
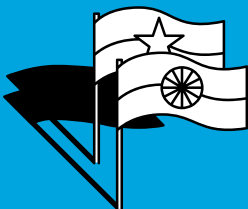
