Free Sundays at Kunsthalle Wien supported by Dorotheum

Beginning this Sunday, Kunsthalle Wien will offer a monthly day of free admission. On the last Sunday of every month, we invite people to our current exhibitions at both the MuseumsQuartier and Karlsplatz locations without charge, thanks to a new partnership with Dorotheum.

Known for presenting internationally acclaimed artists alongside prominent up-and-coming figures, Kunsthalle Wien produces thought-provoking exhibitions that reflect upon and engage with the urgent questions of our time. At two locations in the heart of Vienna, visitors can encounter a wide range of artistic practices ranging from painting, sculpture and photography to large-scale installations, film, video and digital media. The current exhibitions include a retrospective of the American painter, Richard Hawkins, a 62-metre mural by the German-british painter, Sophie von Hellermann (both in the Museumsquartier) and a joint exhibition by two recent graduates, Jonida Laçi and Luīze Nežberete who received the 2025 Kunsthalle Wien Prize.

These Free Sundays underscore Kunsthalle Wien's commitment to making contemporary art accessible to all, by eliminating the barriers to participation in its activities. By offering free access to its exhibitions, Kunsthalle Wien aims to extend and promote Vienna's cultural offer to new audiences, including those who feel discouraged by the costs of admission.
